GREETERS / CHECK-IN (6 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

To be the friendly face greeting our guests with children at the Kids Ministry area. We want our families to feel comfortable leaving their children in our care. First time guests will need assistance registering and then be taken to their classrooms.

TIMES:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve in a Kids Ministry Role one service weekly
- Attend quarterly Kids Equip trainings
- Serve one year

PROJECT TEAM (4 Volunteers)

Project Team responsibilities are not Sunday Morning specific.

DESCRIPTION:

Support special projects through the year, such as curriculum prep, special event prep, and special project prep.

TIME:

Flexible around your schedule

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Commit to one year

PKWY NURSERY

(Newborns through 2 years old)

(24 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

Kids learn what it means to praise God through song, prayer & play. Help little ones learn listening skills by reading Bible stories while caring for them. As a team member you will greet parents & kids, assist with activities, and invest in relationships with the children.

TIMES:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve in a Kids Classroom one service weekly
- Attend quarterly Kids Equip trainings
- Serve one year

PKWY LITTLE KIDS

(3, 4, & 5 years old including Kindergarteners)

(24 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

Kids learn about having a relationship with God through song, prayer & play. They hear great stories of faith & memorize God's Word. As a team member you will greet parents & kids, assist with activities, and invest in relationships with the kids. There are also opportunities for classroom storytellers using the provided curriculum.

TIMES:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve in a Kids Classroom one service weekly
- Attend quarterly Kids Equip trainings
- Serve one year



PKWY ELEMENTARY

(1st, 2nd, & 3rd Grades)

(26 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

Investing in kids in the heart of elementary years. As a team member, you will greet parents & kids, assist with activities, and invest in relationships with the kids. There are also opportunities for classroom storytellers using the provided curriculum.

TIMES:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve in a Kids Classroom one service weekly
- Attend quarterly Kids Equip trainings
- Serve one year

PKWY PRETEENS

(4th & 5th Grades)

(12 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

The goal of Pkwy Preteens is to prepare our preteen students for the challenges of tomorrow while teaching them to walk in wisdom today. As a team member, you will work as a team in your classroom and ensure clear biblical communication to students.

TIME:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve with preteens one service weekly
- Attend quarterly Kids Equip trainings
- Serve one year



SPECIAL NEEDS BUDDY

(6 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

This position works one-on-one with a child who may have unique accommodations or need one-on-one attention in the classroom.

TIMES:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve in a Kids Classroom one service weekly
- Attend quarterly Kids Equip trainings
- Serve one year

LIFESAVER TEAM

(20 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

Our regular KM team members sometimes take vacations or get sick. Our Lifesaver Team members save the day by serving in classes when we need a substitute. A Lifesaver can serve weekly, 2x a month or be on a call list to serve on your own timeline and frequency. You can even request which service or certain areas—such as preteens or no diapers!

TIME:

Sundays, 9:00AM–10:45AM or 10:45AM–12:20PM

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve in Pkwy Kids class on your schedule
- Serve one year

ADULT YOUTH LEADER

COMMITMENT:

TIMES:

- Meet with your group once per week.
- Contact group members throughout the week.

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Connect trainings once a month (11:00AM-12:15PM Sundays)
- Serve one year

GUEST EXPERIENCE (20 Volunteers)

(Greeters, Ushers, Welcome Center Hosts,
Worship Center Connectors, Online Hosts)

DESCRIPTION:

Our Sunday morning Connections team helps facilitate a meaningful worship experience by warmly welcoming and helping people to their seats, preparing and serving Communion, getting to know our guests, and serving in other special events, both in person and online when we stream services. You may also help guests find their way where they need to go. For example, Kids Ministry check-in, and help them into next steps of engagement with the church. You'll also help tidy the Worship Center after service.

TIMES:

Sundays – 8:45AM-10:40AM and other special services

OR

Sundays–10:30AM-12:25PM and other special services

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service & serve that same service weekly
- Serve one year

HOSPITALITY TEAM (6 Volunteers)

DESCRIPTION:

This ministry is for those who can offer a warm & generous reception towards our visitors & guests by preparing and serving coffee and refreshments to our various Sunday morning ministries.

TIMES:

Sundays–Before First Service (8:30AM–9:30AM)

OR

Sundays–Before & During Second Service (10:00AM–12:00PM)

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service & serve at the same service weekly
- Serve one year

FACILITIES MINISTRY

FACILITIES MINISTRY

(10 Volunteers)

OPEN AND CLOSE TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

Help make sure the building is open and ready in the mornings and locked up safely after services.

TIMES:

Sundays 7:45 AM and/or 12:30 PM, once a month

PROJECT & MAINTENANCE TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

This ministry is for those who want to use their hands-on abilities to help maintain and update our facility and landscaping.

- (1) Assist our landscaping team with weekly maintenance on Saturdays during the mowing season.
- (2) Leverage professional skills/certifications to help with regular facility repair and maintenance.
- (3) Channel your passion for gardening through beautification and maintenance of flowerbeds.

SPECIAL EVENTS TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

This ministry is for those who are willing to help with set up & tear down.

- (1) Reconfigure the Worship Center for special events and then resetting the Worship Center for Sunday morning worship services.
- (2) Assisting with set up & tear down for outdoor events, like Baptism.

COMMITMENT FOR ALL FACILITY TEAMS:

SERVANTS ON STANDBY(SOS)

SOS HANDYMAN TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

SOS is a network of people ready to serve others in the church or community when they need some assistance (moving, yardwork, handyman repairs). Sign up if you're willing and able to be on standby to help when the need arises. When a need arises you will be notified via email and you can determine if you have the necessary skill needed and if you are available.

SOS CARE TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

Those who are available during the week to assist church family with care such as rides to the doctor, house cleaning help, meals, etc. would be a great fit to our Care Team! Needs would be scheduled ahead of time and you would essentially be "on call" to serve when needs arise as your schedule allows.

SOS MEDICAL TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

If you are a medical professional or have training in emergency response, we'd love to have a resource list of those willing to be contacted in case of a medical emergency during Sunday morning services.

SOS SAFETY TEAM

DESCRIPTION:

Team who oversees the safety of our building/grounds and church family on Sunday morning. Often active or retired law enforcement or military.

TIMES:

- Sundays 8:45am-12:30pm, as scheduled (2-3 times a month)
- Safety Team Meetings once a month (third Sundays, 12:30-2:00pm)

COMMITMENT FOR ALL SOS TEAMS:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve one year

CARING ADVOCATE

- Women who will attend the Arise events to be an encourager and friendly visitor for the single moms we serve.

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship service weekly
- Serve one year

RADIANCE WOMEN'S CENTER

Radiance Women's Center exists to love, in a Christ-like way, all women who are in need of physical, emotional, and spiritual help when facing an unexpected pregnancy.

DESCRIPTION:

- Answering the phone 3-4 hours per week.
- Minister directly to the women in need.

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship one service weekly
- Serve one year

EMBRACE GRACE

Embrace Grace is a biblically-based support group for single, pregnant women. The vision is for every woman with an unplanned pregnancy to have a church to go to for spiritual, emotional, and physical support.

- Postpartum meals for moms

COMMITMENT:

- Serve one semester

EMBRACE LIFE

Embrace Life is a support group where single moms can find hope, experience joy, and build community. It's a great next step for the moms who were part of an Embrace Grace group during their pregnancy.

WAYS YOU CAN SERVE:

- Group Supporter
- Brunch Team (Provide brunch items once or twice a month)
- Prayer Team

COMMITMENT:

- Attend worship service weekly
- Serve one semester

CIRCLE OF HOPE COMMUNITY CENTER

Circle of Hope Community Center is Pflugerville's food pantry and resource center. Their mission is to provide food, resources, and hope to their neighbors in need.

DESCRIPTION:

FOOD RECOVERY OR DISTRIBUTION

Volunteer with the food pantry in sorting, stocking, and shopping for our clients at COH, or be part of the team that puts the food in cars.

- 90 minutes (1:00-2:30pm) one Friday a month, for one school year

 - Sparks Club Leaders teach groups of 5-10 4th Graders for 90 minutes (11:45am-1:15pm) one Friday a month. You can choose from cooking, art, crafts, soccer, ukulele, STEM, drama, golf, or let us know what you'd like to teach!
